Non-Profit Recipients Chosen to Receive Proceeds from the Tustin Street Fair & Chili Cook-Off

TUSTIN, Calif. – The 2015 Tustin Street Fair and Chili Cook-Off Committee, in partnership with the Tustin Community Foundation, has chosen two designated nonprofits to receive proceeds from this year's event. These include Tustin High School Football Booster Club and Foothill High School Instrumental Music Guild.

The Tustin High Football Booster Club supports the Tustin High football program primarily through its fundraising efforts. Nearly 50% of the players on the Tustin football team are from low-income families. Many would not be on the team without the fundraising efforts of the booster club. As a Tustin player, the boys remain physically active and learn perseverance and determination. They learn how to cooperate with one another and to work together as a team. It is the hope of the coaches and the booster club that the boys will carry these lifelong skills into adulthood. The team is currently raising funds to replace worn/damaged uniforms and repair or replace helmets which failed inspection for the 2015 season.
