City of Tustin Participates in Red Shirt Friday Program

Tustin, (CA) – On June 18th, 2013, the Tustin City Council unanimously passed a resolution declaring every Friday, in the City of Tustin, to be “Red Shirt Friday.” Red Shirt Friday is a nationwide initiative that is recognized amongst various organizations, private businesses and public entities that visibly demonstrates support for our men and women in uniform.

“By wearing red every Friday, the City of Tustin is announcing that we are grateful to our soldiers past, present, and future for their bravery and sacrifice,” said Mayor Al Murray. “Tustin’s participation is a simple gesture that demonstrates our longstanding support for military service members, and I invite residents, visitors and employees to embrace Red Shirt Friday.”

In 1945, the Red Shirt Friday Program originated during WWII to show support of the military as they defended our country. Currently, there are six cities in Orange County, aside from Tustin, who have also proclaimed to support Red Shirt Friday: Yorba Linda, Santa Ana, Brea, La Habra, Westminster and Orange.
