### **Tustin Awarded Grant for Frontier Park Improvements**

TUSTIN, Calif. – The State Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has announced that the City of Tustin will receive a grant for \$260,700 for improvements at Frontier Park through the Housing Related Parks (HRP) Program.

The HRP Program was developed to increase the overall supply of housing to lower income households by providing financial incentives to cities and counties with newly constructed units affordable to very low or low-income households. To be eligible for the HRP Program, local governments must have a housing element that has been determined by HCD to comply with State Housing Element law and must submit General Plan Annual Progress Reports for applicable program years.

The grant funds are required to be used for the costs of park and recreation facility creation, development, or rehabilitation, including the acquisition of land and the construction, rehabilitation, and acquisition of park equipment and physical property.

This award will allow Tustin to implement improvements at Frontier Park such as sprayground recycled water equipment or other needed park amenities.
